Out of custody appearances will resume when the Chief Justice's Order preventing them expires.

Pleas by mail and liberal petty resolutions will continue to be encouraged and accepted.

FIRST SIX WEEKS:

Out of custody calendars limited to domestics, DWIs, assaults and GMDs. Goal is fewer than 15 per half day per calendar (5 per hour).

One extra calendar of up to 5 defendants daily for prosecutor to designate other cases

Must contact Admin of the courthouse at least two weeks before the date to designate the 5 cases.

Defendants will check in at the counter on C-11. They will be called into the courtroom in small groups.

We will try to spread hearing times throughout the morning and afternoon, but notices already sent. Expect to work later in the afternoons.

Please discuss pretrials in advance, so there is not a line of defense attorneys to talk to prosecutors.

EVD hearings can be submitted on paper by agreement. Admin will assign the motion to a judge.

EVD hearings scheduled downtown will go forward as scheduled.

Physical changes to allow social distancing and physical separations attached to this document. (masks, gloves, sanitizer, Plexiglas, cleaning schedule)

CONTINUED:

Other case types continued to July and August.

No court trials until July.

JURY TRIALS:

No juries for out of custody cases through mid-June.

Cases will stay on the trial calendar if you do not contact the court with a settlement or joint request to continue the trial.

Master Trial Calendar will be divided ahead of time, so check the boards for your courtroom. Do not all go to 1159.

WEEK 7 AND BEYOND:

All types of cases heard.

There will be a large back-up of cases not settled by mail.

Will work later into the afternoon/early evening.
